Baby animals alone are probably just fine.

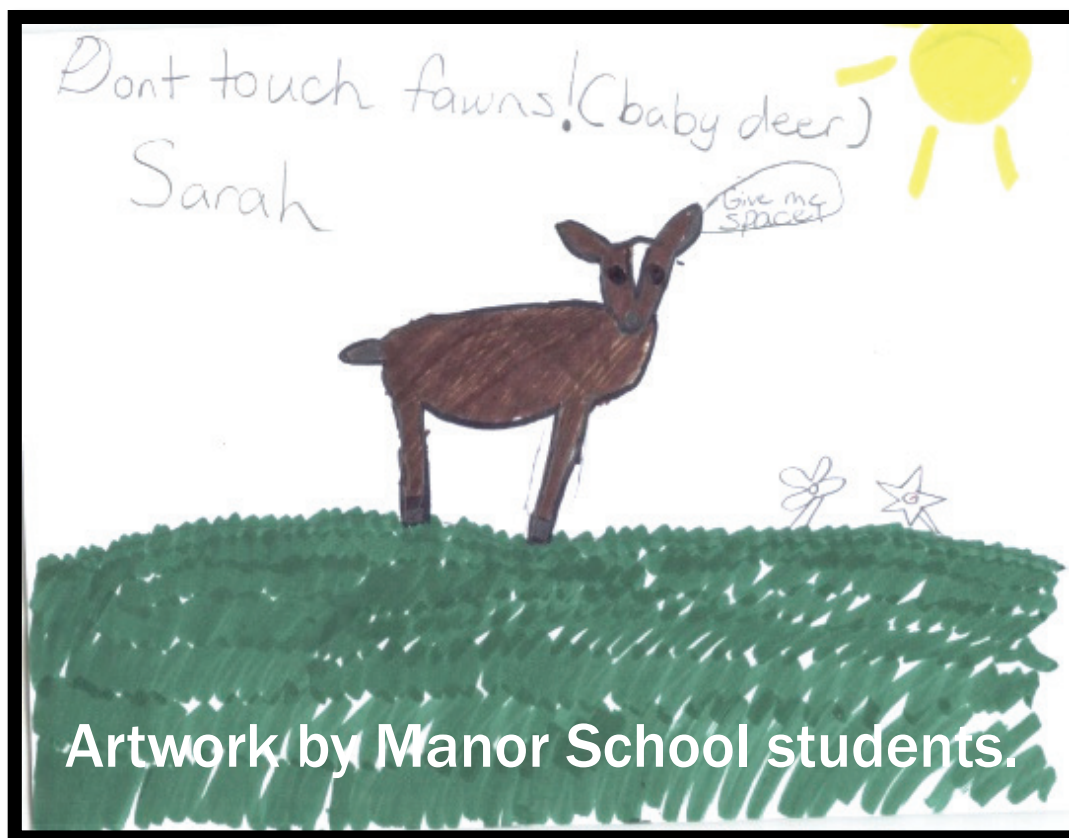

Deer mothers leave their young for up to *12 hours* at a time! **Review The 5 C's to make sure the baby really needs your help before you take any action.**

The 5 C's

Ask yourself:

1. Are they Crying?
2. Are they Coming towards you?
3. Are they Covered in blood or insects?
4. Have they been Caught by a dog or cat?
5. Are they Cold?
