“Take a guess at when these animals are awake below!” Color the animals:

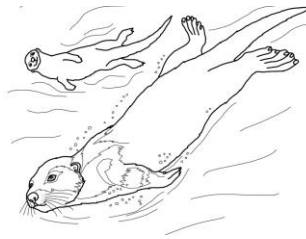
BLUE for **crepuscular** (dawn and dusk)

ORANGE for **diurnal** (daytime)



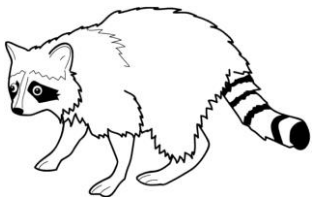

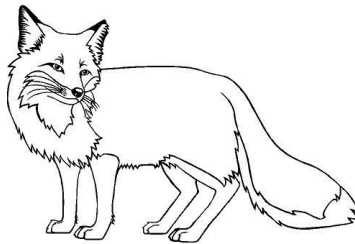

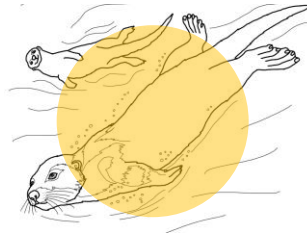
