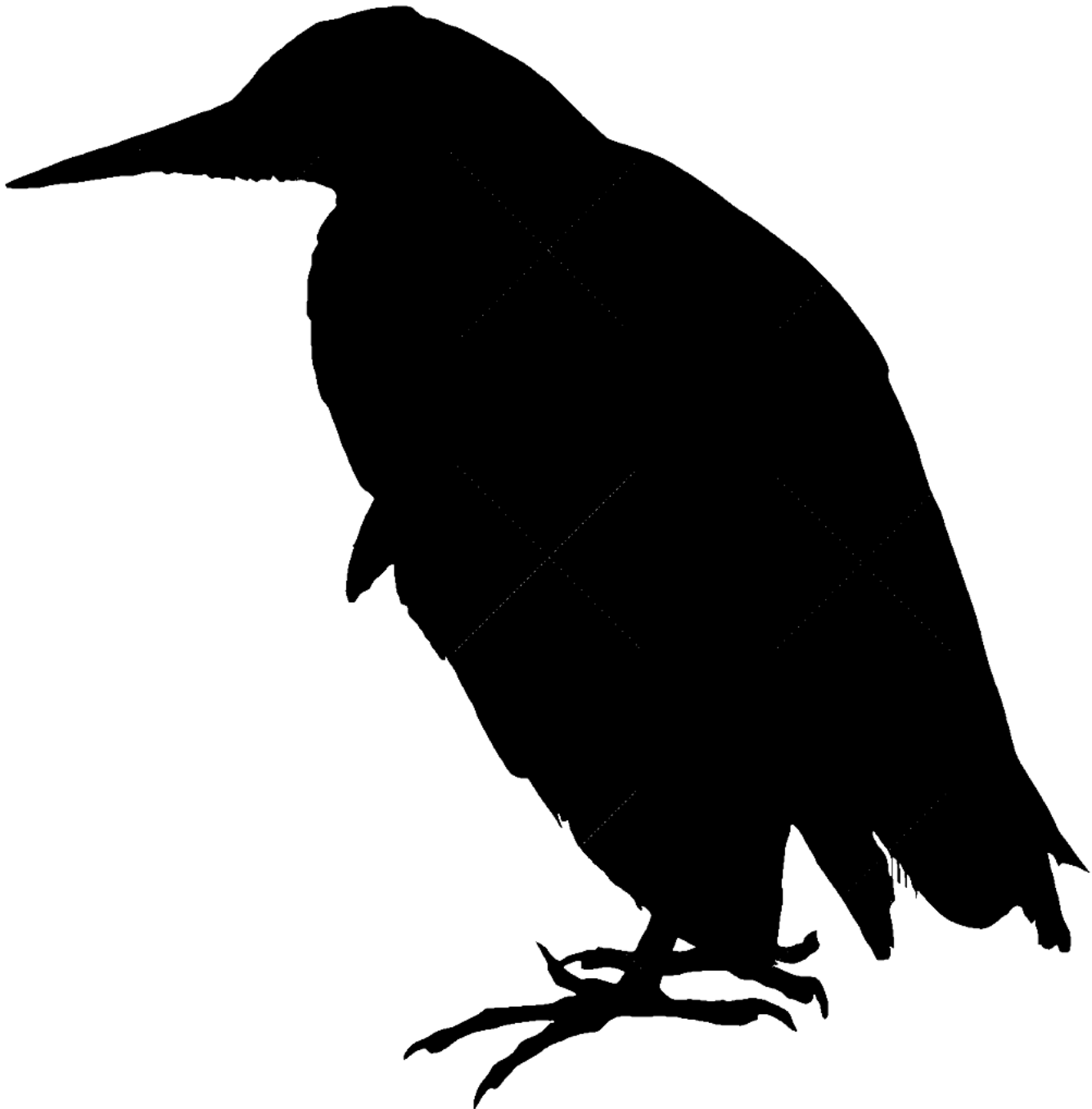
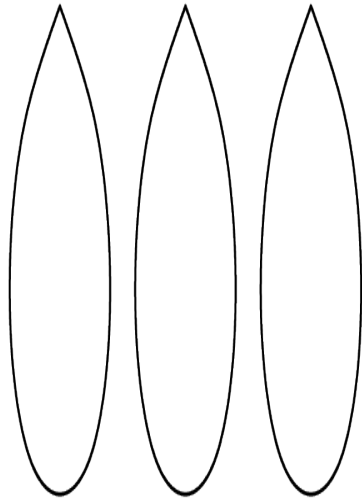
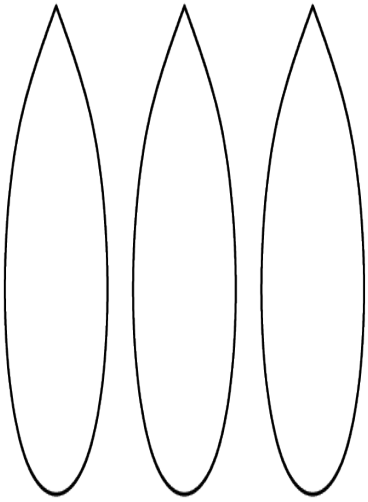
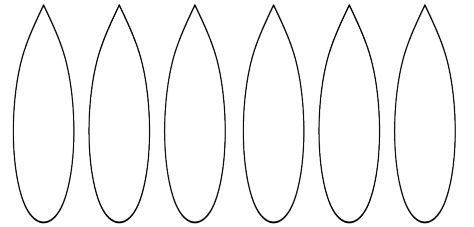
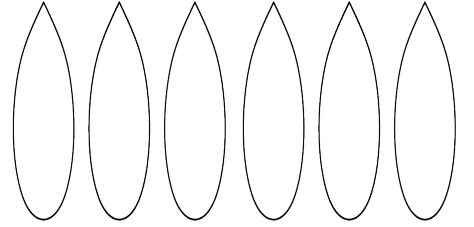
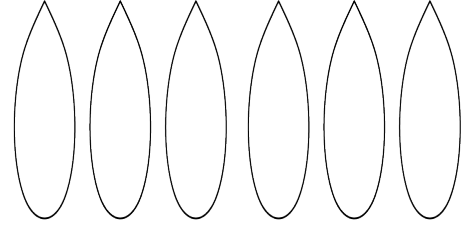
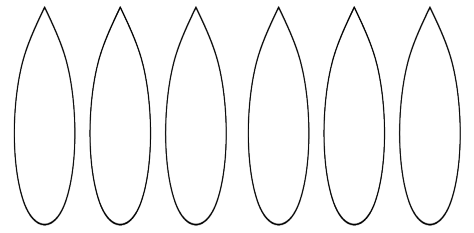
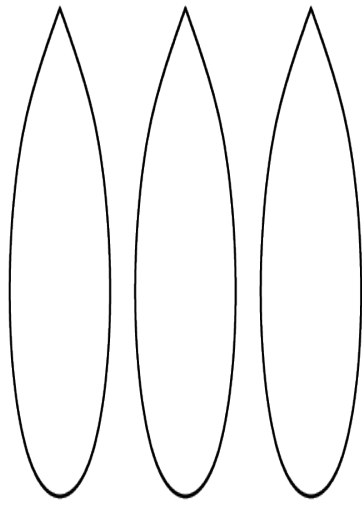
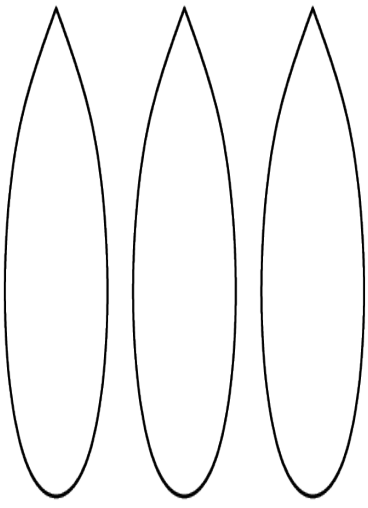


Wild Wetlands

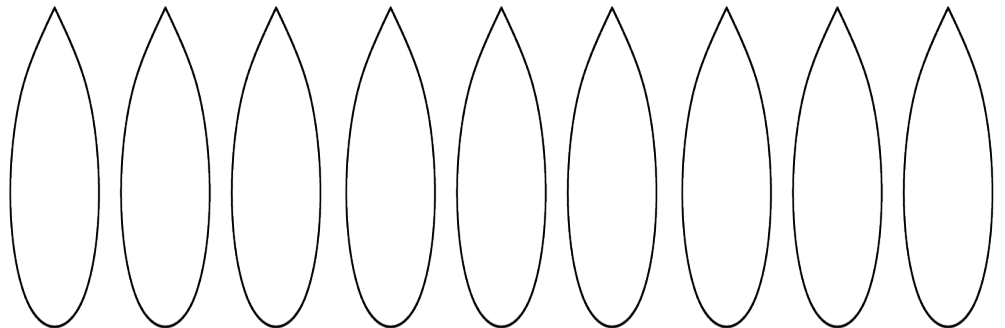
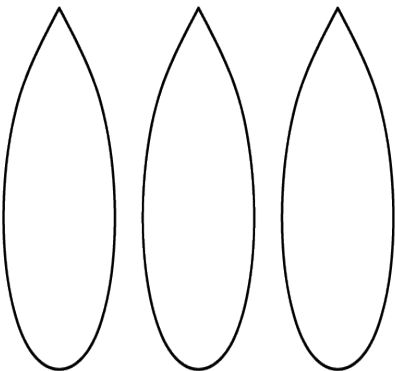
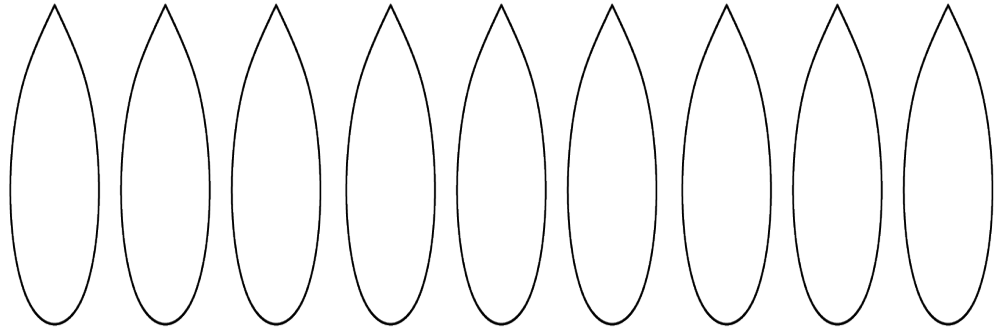
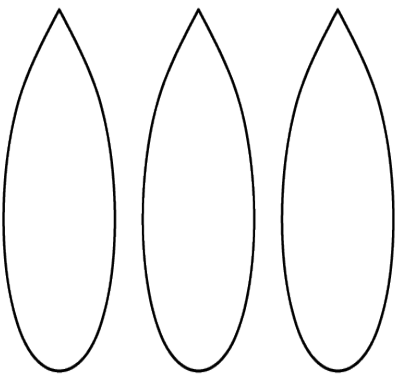
- 1- Choose a place where you would like to make your Bittern hide
